

Highlights

Axis was commissioned by the University of Greenwich to complete external repairs and internal refurbishment to Devonport House. Devonport House is a bespoke modern conversion of a historic building, providing 125 rooms to accommodate students. We had to erect bespoke scaffolding to all facades and chimneys to complete the external repair and restoration works.

Works were carried out to the external fabric of the building, including slate roof repairs, replacement and repair of Portland stone dentils and renewal of lead work to parapet walls, cornices, gullies and flat roof dormers. The existing box sash windows and doors were repaired using Timber care repair systems in preparation for redecoration of the windows, doors, external fascia, guttering and boundary railings.
