

Highlights

Axis was awarded the contract by The Portman Estate to undertake internal and external fabric repairs and redecorations on several of their prestigious properties and communal areas. This project required a sensitive approach, as some of the architecture dates back to the mid-1800s. Axis' extensive knowledge and experience of working on Heritage properties meant we were able to offer the advice and skills when carrying out the sensitive works.

External works involved roof inspections where visible timber was assessed for defects or damage which was then repaired or replaced accordingly. Redecoration of previously painted surfaces was completed with care and consideration to ensure the building's original features were not compromised and that the originality and unique state was maintained. All surfaces were inspected and treated as necessary before the painting work began.
