

## **Highlights**

Axis was appointed by the Residents' Association at Semley House to renew and refurbish the entranceway to the block of flats.

To improve the building's aesthetic and in keeping with the prestigious postcode, Axis re-cladded the front of the building's entrance in high quality Portland stone.

Gold leafing applied by an expert craftsman was used to highlight the name and area code engraved in the stone.

The stone cladding was mechanically fixed to the underside of the canopy and we added a granite up-stand to the base of the façade for a clean and sophisticated appearance.

To improve security, we upgraded the canopy lighting with low-maintenance and energy efficient solutions and installed a new mechanically-assisted entrance door system in a stylish brushed-steel finish. The existing key fob system was maintained and linked into the new door's high-security locking mechanism.

The entranceway is the only point of entry for the 102 apartments within the building and so managing the building's security was a top priority throughout the project.
